WE HOSTED 341 virtual social, educational, and cultural programs and 13 live events during this pandemic year.


SOCIAL, EDUCATIONAL, AND CULTURAL EVENTS were attended by 193 people this pandemic year; 82 members and 111 non-members.

VOLUNTEERS DONATED OVER 3100 HOURS serving our members, including over 1900 hours behind the scenes to make the village function efficiently.


VOLUNTEERS GAVE 233 ROUND-TRIP RIDES for medical appointments, social events, and errands even in this pandemic year.


